

2025 Senior Farmer's Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) Produce Vouchers

2025 voucher distribution will be **in person** at PCA and participating senior centers from June 23rd through September 30th **while supplies last.** Please see the back of this memo for distribution hours at participating senior centers. For 2025, qualified participants are eligible to receive five \$5 vouchers, for a total of \$25.

If you want to receive SFMNP produce vouchers for 2025, we recommend that you return the completed application form <u>in-person</u> to a participating senior center or PCA's office AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. You can find an application form on our website (<u>www.pcacares.org/produce</u>), at a distribution site or by emailing <u>sfmnp@pcacares.org</u> to request a copy.

There are 3 ways to submit the COMPLETED application (please complete ALL information requested):

- Go to your local participating senior center after June 23rd. This is a first come, first serve basis where you can receive your vouchers on the same day. You can find the list of participating senior centers on the back of this memo along with their days and hours of distribution.
- Take the completed application to Philadelphia Corporation for Aging (PCA) at 642 N. Broad Street Philadelphia, PA 19130 after June 23rd Monday through Friday 9am-2pm. This is also a first come, first served basis where you can receive your vouchers on the same day.
- 3. If you want to pick up vouchers for someone who is unable to pick them up in-person themselves, we offer a proxy option. You can find a proxy form on our website (<u>www.pcacares.org/produce</u>), at a distribution site or by emailing <u>sfmnp@pcacares.org</u> to request a copy. The proxy form needs to be filled out and signed by both the proxy and the program participant. One person can serve as a proxy for a maximum of *four participants* per year. Please fill out the proxy form completely and bring it to PCA or a participating senior center.
- 4. In-person distribution will take priority. If supplies still last, we will consider mail-in applications towards the middle of the season.

Make sure to circle your ETHNICITY AND RACE on the application and check off the box about nutrition education. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED. This letter does not guarantee that you will be able to receive the SFMNP vouchers, as they will be distributed on a first-come, first-serve basis.
